Preservation Class

The best preservation car or motorcycle is an unrestored and original vehicle which has been properly maintained in good operating condition. It is also a vehicle that is a model year 1987 or older. Vehicles that are seriously deteriorated barn finds or static non-running displays are not normally eligible for preservation judging. Special Displays

Special Displays, as the name suggests, bring together a select group of curated vehicles that illustrate an important element in the history and evolution of motor vehicles. To broaden the scope of these displays, by default **the vehicles are not judged**. These are the Special Displays for 2025:

SD2 Factory Modified Europeans (e.g. Alpina, AMG, Ruf, Singer)

Examples of European cars that have been modified prior to purchase by one of the major tuner companies.

SD3 Turbo Showcase - Significant Turbo Vehicles through 1993

In honor of the invention of turbocharging 120 years ago we are looking to showcase significant turbocharged vehicles that highlight the history and evolution of forced induction.

SD4 Bugatti 100th Anniversary

Examples of the French marque from across the last 100 years.

SD5 VW Bus 75th & Beetle 80th

Examples of Volkswagens that highlight the long history of the VW Bus and Beetle.

SD6 First and Last Responders; Ambulances and Hearses

A tribute to iconic first and last responder vehicles.

SD7 Ford Shelby GT 350 60th

Fine examples of the Shelby icon.
